Approximately 800 adults and 200 children attended the event. Over 70 employee and family volunteers, auxiliary and 20 nursing students help run the event. Approximately 500 flu shots were given. 3. Flu Clinics – City of Alameda, AUSD, Community Ms. Nakada informed the committee that the Hospital sponsored a flu shot clinic for the City of Alameda employees and provided 100 flu shots. November 18-19 the hospital will be sponsoring a flu shot clinic for the Alameda Unified School District. The hospital will also be planning another community flu shot clinic in December. 4. Alameda Elders Communities Ms. Nakada announced that the Alameda Elder Communities (AEC) will be hosting a seminar on Navigating Senior Housing Options. The seminar will be held at the Hospital.	
	C. Business Associations 1. Chamber of Commerce Mr. Eloe informed the committee about an preliminary discussions with the city and business associations to combine all of the Alameda business associations into one organization. 2. Abbott Diabetes Mr. Eloe also informed the committee about future collaboration possibilities with Abbott Diabetes, including sponsorships and participation at community events. Committee Structure and Purpose

Recommendation:

To approve the revisions to the standing committee structure as outlined below.

STRUCTURE AND PURPOSE:

- 1. Community Relations Committee:
 - a. Primary Purpose: The primary purpose of the Community Relations Committee is to develop a community engagement and outreach plan that supports the hospital's strategic plan and annual goals. The Committee advises the board on strategies and programs to enhance health care services to the community, increase the district's (hospital's) market share, effectively position the hospital for success based on information flow with the community and elected officials and support the fund-raising objectives of the Alameda Hospital Foundation.
 - b. Committee Composition and Voting Rights: The committee shall be comprised of the following members:
 - i. At least two members of the City of Alameda Health Care District Board of Directors all of whom shall be voting members of the committee. One of these members also shall be appointed to serve as the committee co-chair. The other co-chair will be an at large member from the community who will be elected each year.
 - i-ii. The President of the City of Alameda Health Care District
 Board of Directors shall be an ex-officio, non-noting
 member, unless the President is serving as a voting member
 of the committee.
 - ii.iii. Up to three members of the Alameda Hospital Medical Staff all of whom shall be voting members of the committee.

- iii.iv. Up to eleven at large members chosen for expertise needed by the district all of whom shall be voting members of the committee. At least one member at large shall also be a member of the Alameda Hospital Foundation Board.
- iv.v. The City of Alameda Health Care District Chief Executive Officer, and other hospital management as delegated, who shall not be voting members of the committee.
- v.vi. The Executive Director of the Alameda Hospital
 Foundation and the Director of Community Relations shall
 serve as staff to the Committee and collaborate with the
 Committee co-chairs on the preparation of agenda.
- c. Terms: The committee shall be appointed annually.
- d. Meeting Frequency: The committee shall meet at least quarterly.
