	C. Community Relations and Outreach	
	Stroke Awareness Campaign	
	Ms. Nakada reviewed the Stroke Awareness Campaign. The next Stroke Risk Assessment is June 3, 2011 and will be held at a Harbor Bay location in the afternoon. The June 30, 2011 date has only a few appointments available and will be held on the main island.	
	Ms. Nakada announced the Community Stroke Forum is taking place on May 23, 2011 at 6:00 pm. Dr. Claudine Dutaret, Dr. Robert Gingery, and Dr. Eric Otani will address treatment, diagnosis, and prevention regarding stroke.	
	2. Community Calendar	
	Ms. Nakada presented a calendar of events taking place in regards to Alameda Hospital and the surrounding community. A community calendar is available on the Alameda Hospital website.	
	3. Let's Move Alameda	
	Ms. Nakada reviewed the involvement of Alameda Hospital with local organizations to develop a city wide campaign focused on childhood obesity. The development of a summer health and fitness program for youth includes: awareness of community resources for youth, a Summer Activity Journal, and positive rewards such as vouchers through the Farmers Market. The Summer Activity Journal will be available at all participating partners such as the local library, Girls inc., the Boys & Girls Club of Alameda as well as numerous summer events such as the Sand Sculpture Event at Crown Beach. Youth will be able to submit their completed Journal at the Webster Street Jam on September 10, 2011.	Ms. Nakada will further research social media options for Alameda Hospital.

	Dr. Yeh mentioned the importance of utilizing social media such as Facebook when it addresses youth.	
	Ms. Nakada replied Alameda Hospital has researched social media types and has intentions on developing a Facebook location.	
	4. Communications Plan	
	Tom Clifford, a representative of Tramutola, gave a presentation regarding a communication enhancement plan. Mr. Clifford interviewed several community members to gain an insight of how Alameda Hospital is viewed from a community standpoint. The interviews concluded that Alameda Hospital needs to reach out to all community members, such as elected officials, staff, and individual households. Currently, Ms. Stebbins has been giving presentations to the City Council and meeting with key leaders of the community to increase awareness. Building relationships with Alameda County public officials and staff is a key component of the plan. Alameda Hospital plans to utilize direct marketing such as door-to-door, telephone marketing, and volunteer organizations.

	D. CEO Update	
	Ms. Stebbins stated the importance of bringing awareness to the community of how Alameda Hospital exceeds average, such as the extremely low rates of infection. In the future, hospitals will be reimbursed by Medicare based on these scores.	
	Ms. Stebbins has been working with the California Hospital Association to develop a more efficient budget. Medicare will be lowering the rates of compensation for long-term care which will lower our income by about \$2 million. Programs such as the Wound Care Center, Outpatient Physical Therapy Programs, and the introduction of Plastic Surgery are being developed	
	E. Physicians Relations Update	
	Mr. Corica reviewed that Alameda Hospital's active Medical Staff is composed of approximately 90 doctors directed by Medical Staff President, Dr. Jim Yeh. Eighty percent (80%) are Board Certified, while twenty percent (20%) are Dual Board Certified. Alameda Hospital is considering the expansion of space for doctor offices in the future Marina Village location. Currently, Alameda Hospital has an outpatient laboratory and physician offices at the Alameda Towne Center Clinic location.	
	F. Alameda Hospital Foundation Update	
	Mr. Eloe announced the generous offer made by the Foundation to Alameda Hospital to grant \$225,000 for the new Wound Care Center. The Guardian Angel program, explained in more detail on the website, is available for anyone to donate funds to the hospital in honor of a person who has provided exceptional care at Alameda Hospital. A fundraiser will be held on June 11, 2011 at the Rock Wall Winery. A portion of the ticket price supports the Alameda Hospital Foundation.
